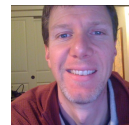

We are nearly bubbling over with excitement to share our 2010 workshops with you. Registration is open to members so if you have a workshop you want to take, head to our website and sign up now. If you aren't already a member, you can become one when you sign up for workshops.

This last month has seen the weather change from violent winter rains to daffodils and sunshine...and back to rain again. We have been hard at work planning for next year's Residency Program, planning the Sitka Art Invitational, and planning our grant-writing strategy. New residents have arrived and begun settling into their studios while visitors drop by to check on the status of workshops or just investigate who we are and what we do.

Sitka has some exciting projects underway.

- In partnership with the city of Lincoln City, Let There Be Arts, and the Lincoln City schools, Sitka has created

- Our expanded Residency Program for writers has begun with Writers Dojo and Wordstock partnerships. They will help us select exceptional writers for the program. 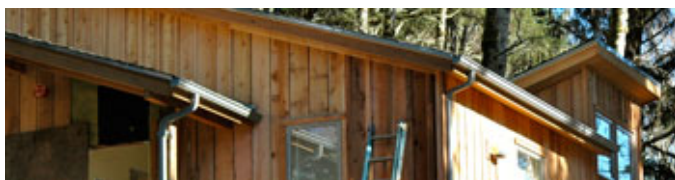

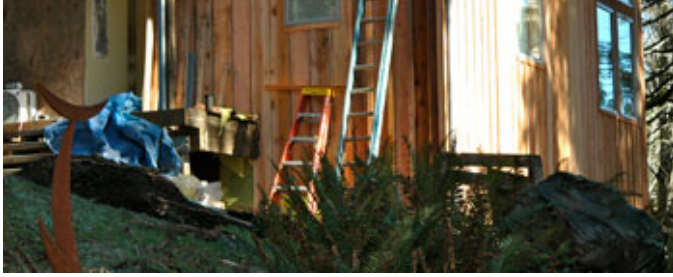

>>Construction Update



The windows are in, the walls are insulated, sheet-rocked and painted. The cabinets arrive next week and then the radiant heat floors will get installed. The exterior siding is nearly complete on the



upper cabin and the rebuilt stairways along the Boyden Studio are almost finished. It's looking good!

The stone masons also completed the stonework in the courtyard and with new windows in the Edelman Studio, you can really enjoy the view back up to the forest.

The two new cabins should be finished by mid-March and then they'll be ready for two new artists to dig deeply into their surroundings and get busy creating new work. These are exciting times!
